Put six months of your life into intensive training in singing, dancing and acting. You'll begin with three months full-time training in Canberra—then you'll take those skills off to London's West End! In the UK you'll spend time training

with top-level professionals. You'll also see some of the latest musical theatre shows and learn about the industry. Then, on your return, you'll put what you now know into practice as you rehearse and perform in a major musical production. Earn your qualification... and come out ready to audition for your next big theatrical adventure!

### WHAT'S IN STORE FOR ME IN THIS COURSE?

- 24 WEEKS TRAINING, FOUR DAYS PER WEEK. TUITION INCLUDES PRIVATE SINGING LESSONS.
- PARTICIPATE IN A MAJOR MUSICAL THEATRE PRODUCTION, AS WELL AS SEVERAL SMALLER PERFORMANCES

### ENTRY IS BY AUDITION:

Participants in this course are expected to have a background in singing, dance and/or acting and must be prepared to commit for the full six months. See website to register online. Acceptances are issued within one week of the audition.

### AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS:

There is a \$22 application fee for this course. Auditions are held between July to November. See website for dates.

### AUDITION PREPARATION:

You must prepare a solo song from the musical theatre tradition. (You will need to bring sheet music for your song.)

Secondly, you must prepare a two-minute monologue. This may be an extract from a larger script or a stand-alone piece. Your monologue should be age-appropriate. It must be fully memorised. Consider how you can express your character through your piece.

In addition to your song and monologue presentation you will participate in a group dance workshop where the instructor will evaluate your capacity to undertake the dance component of the course.

### ACCEPTANCE:

On acceptance of a place in the course, students are required to pay a deposit of \$1,000 towards course fees.
